Heard Mr.A. Prabhakaran, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner M/s.M. Lalitha, learned Government Advocate, for the first respondent, and Mr.K. Venkatesh, the learned Government Advocate for the second respondent.

2. The petitioners are Transport Contractors, and they challenged the Goods Detention Notice issued by the second respondent, on the ground that the goods were not accompanied by proper documents.

3. At the time, when the Writ Petitions was entertained, no interim direction was issued for release of the goods. Thus, by efflux of time, nothing further survives for adjudication in this Writ Petition.

4. Accordingly, the Writ Petitions are closed. In the event, the compounding notice had been issued, or any demand had been raised against the petitioner, it is open to the petitioner to approach appropriate Authority for necessary relief. No costs.
