Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a Writ of mandamus to direct the first respondent to accept Personal Bond for the balance of disputed tax in lieu of payment of further 25% of tax and Bank Guarantee for the balance amount till disposal of the appeal pending before him.

2. The writ petition has been filed praying for issuance of a writ of mandamus to accept personal bond for the balance amount of disputed ax in lieu of payment of 25% of tax and Bank Guarantee pending disposal of the appeal before the 1st respondent.

3. Though the writ petition was admitted, no interim order was granted. By this time, the appeal itself would have been disposed of. Therefore, there is no necessity to keep this writ

petition and the same stands disposed of leaving open all issues to be raised before the appropriate forum. No costs.

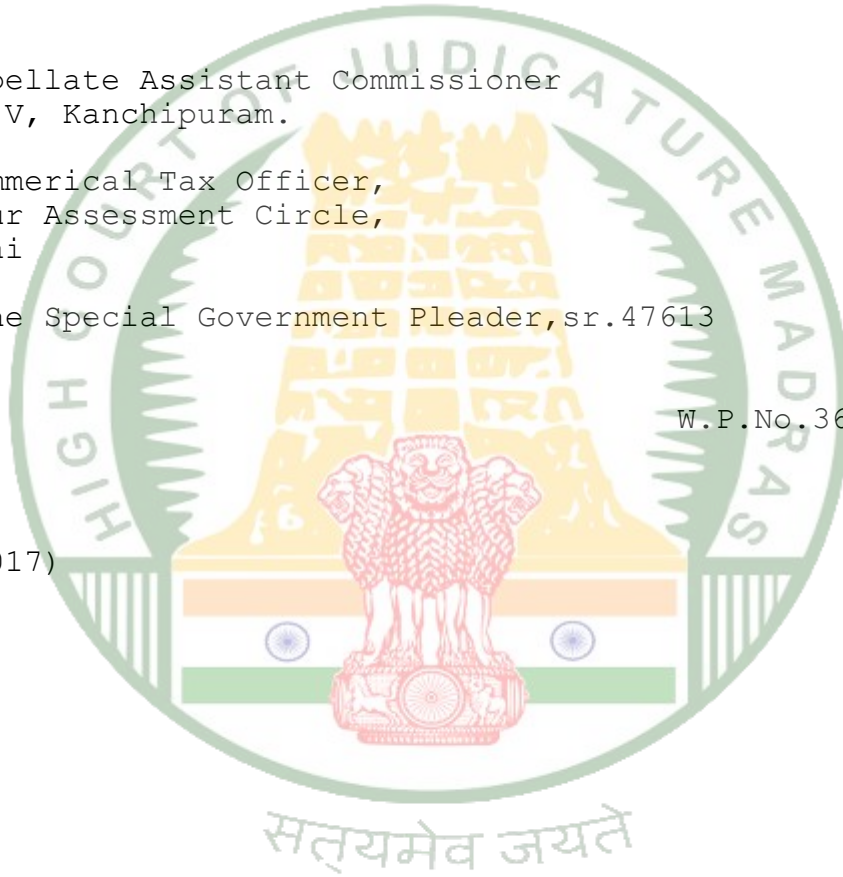
