Writ Petition No.18846 of 2004 filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus to direct the respondent and authorities functioning under him to receive the application of the petitioner for supply of electricity, consider the same and direct regular supply of electricity of residential tariff basis to the various units of the petitioner in No.7, Azizmulk 1st Street, Thousand Lights, Chennai-6, without insisting upon the production of the completion certificate from the CMDA/Corporation of Chennai, in the light of the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003, within such time as may be fixed by this Court.

Writ Petition No.18847 of 2004 filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus to direct the respondent and authorities functioning under him to receive the application of the petitioner for supply of electricity, consider the same and direct regular supply of electricity of residential tariff basis to the various units of the petitioner in New No.18, College Road, Nungambakkam, Chennai-34, without insisting upon the production of the completion certificate from the CMDA/Corporation of

Chennai, in the light of the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003, within such time as may be fixed by this Court.
