Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Declaration declaring that the action of the respondents in directing the Women Junior Chemists to go the Collieries or Ports situated outside Tamil Nadu for Coal sampling works, as reflected in the Memo No.DCC/TTPS/SC-2/F-JS/D14/2004 dated 08.01.2004 issued by the third respondent as illegal and unconstitutional and consequently, direct the respondents not to depute the Women Junior Chemists for such work.
