2.that the appellant/Transport Corporation be and hereby directed to transfer the award amount, less the amount already deposited, if any, as per the apportionment made by the Tribunal, through RTGS / NEFT to the personal Savings Bank Account Numbers of the claimants, after getting the Account Details from the respective claimants by the officials of the appellant / Transport Corporation on or before 08.02.2017.

3.that there be no order as to costs in this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.
