JUDGMENT

This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal has been filed by the appellant/wife against the decree of divorce granted in H.M.O.P.No.436 of 2014, dated 09.02.2015, on the file of the Family Court, Tirunelveli.

Before us, both parties have appeared and they have filed a joint memorandum of compromise, whereby they have decided to live together as husband and wife, taking into consideration the welfare of the minor daughter.
