2.that the claimants be and hereby are directed to submit their
respective savings Bank Account details along with the copies of
their passbooks to the Tribunal forthwith.

3.that the Appellant-Insurance Company be and is hereby is
directed to deposit the 50% award amount along with accrued interest



and costs less the amount deposited if any to the credit of MCOP No.240/2001 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal III Additional Subordinate Judge, Trichirappalli, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.

4.that the on such deposit, the Tribunal be and hereby is directed to Transfer the entire award amount along with accrued interest and costs directly to the personal savings Bank Account Number of the respective claimants, through RTGS/NEFT system after getting their Account Details, within a period of two weeks thereafter

5.that there be no order as to costs in this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.
