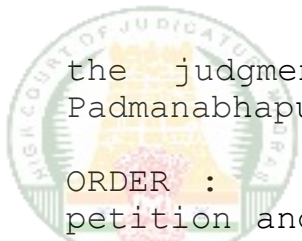
Prayer in CMP(MD). 1042/ 2017 :
