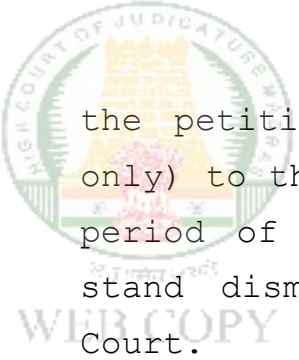
PRAYER IN CRP(MD) No.SR26788 of 2017:
