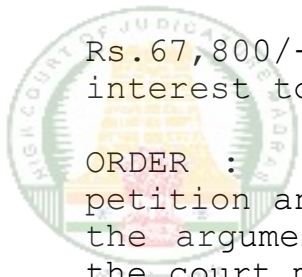

Writ Petition is filed under Article 234 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records connected with the impugned order of rejection of pensionary benefits passed by the 3rd respondent in his Letter No.தமிழகம்(மது)/த.ம/மது/ஒ/1667, dated 23.06.2005 and confirmed by the 2nd respondent in his Letter No.CAD/PF/50 dated 02.08.2012 and quash the same and consequently direct the respondents to sanction pension leave salary and other retirement benefits and also to settle the Post Retirements Benefits of



Rs.67,800/- under the Post Retirement Benefit Scheme along with interest to the petitioner for his 16 years of qualifying service.
