PRAYER IN CMA(MD) No.SR39947 of 2015:-

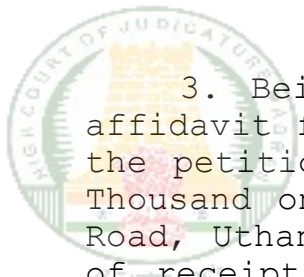
