PRAYER IN W.A. (SR) 37739/2016:

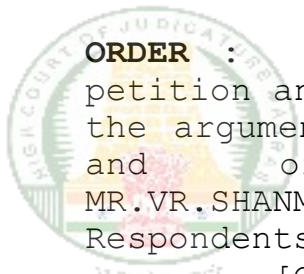

To pass an order of stay of all further proceedings of the Impugned Order in NA.KA.No.4934/2015/M, dated 11.01.2016 on the file of the Respondent No.2 pending disposal of the above Writ Petition.

Prayer in WP(MD) . 2693/ 2016 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Certiorari to call for the records pertaining to the Impugned Order in NA.KA.No.4934/2015/M, dated 11.01.2016 on the file of the Respondent No.2 and quash the same as illegal.
