PRAYER IN CMA(MD) No.SR6334 of 2017:

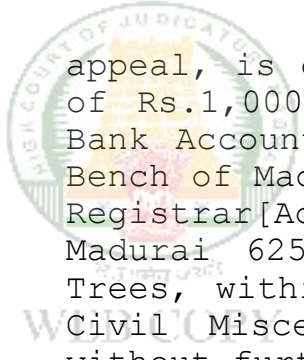
