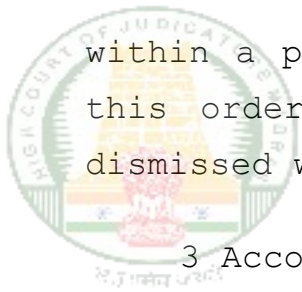
PRAYER IN SA(MD) No.SR7890 of 2016:

ORDER : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.T.ANTONY ARUL RAJ, Advocate for the petitioner and the court made the following order:-

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

2 There is a delay of 232 days in representing the papers. Though the petitioner has satisfactorily explained the reasons for the delay in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, since the delay is on the higher side, the same can be condoned on payment of costs. Hence, the delay of 232 days in representing the paper is condoned on condition that the petitioner paying a sum of Rs.500/-



within a period of **one week** from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing which the petition shall stand automatically dismissed without further reference to this Court.
