PRAYER IN CMP(MD)1889/2017 IN SA(MD)SR43791/2015

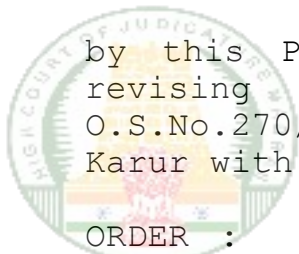

ORDER : These petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petitions and the affidavits filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.J.PRABAKARAN, Advocate for the petitioner in both petitions the court made the following order:-

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. There is a delay of 237 and 187 days respectively in representing the papers. Though the petitioner has satisfactorily explained the reasons for the delay, since the delay is on the higher side, I am of the view that in the interest of Justice, the delay can be condoned on payment of cost. Accordingly, the delay of 237 and 187 days respectively in representing the papers is condoned on condition that the petitioner paying a sum of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) to the Rojavanam Homeless & Aged Care Centre, Melur Road, Uthangudi, Madurai within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing which these petitions shall stand automatically dismissed without further reference to this Court.

3. Accordingly, these petitions are ordered.
