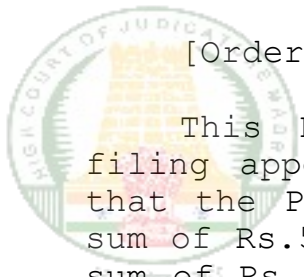
PRAYER IN WA(MD) No.SR10445 of 2017:

Prayer in WP(MD). 5248/ 2010 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a WRIT OF CERTIORARIFIED MANDAMUS calling for the records relating to the award of the Labour Court Madurai in I.D.No. 142/1998 dated 18.9.2007 and quash the same in so far the denial of backwages to the petitioner herein is concerned and consequently direct the 1st respondent Management to pay full back wages to the petitioner.

ORDER : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.PORKODI KARNAN, Advocate for the petitioner the court made the following order:-

It is made clear that if the cost is not paid by the Petitioners within the time stipulated in this Order, the present Miscellaneous Petition shall stand dismissed automatically without any further reference to this Court.
