PRAYER IN CMA(MD) No.SR2155 of 2016:

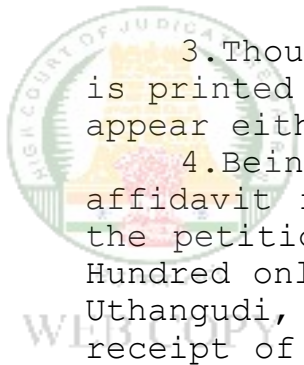
