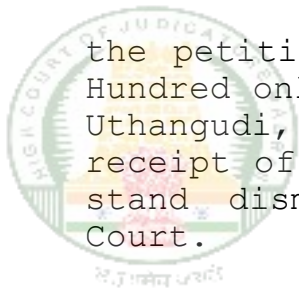
This petition is filed to condone the delay of 354 days in filing the above appeal.
