Prayer in CMP(MD). 7067/ 2017 IN SA No.1829 of 1997:

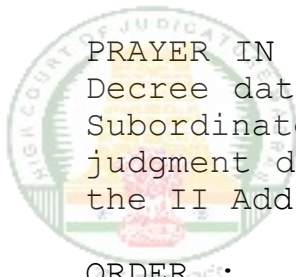
