Prayer in CRL OP(MD). 7130/ 2017 :

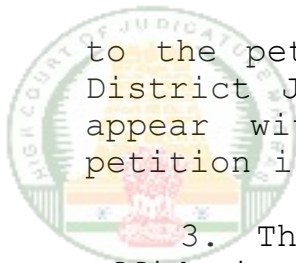

Order : This petition coming on for hearing on this day, upon perusing the petition and affidavits and material papers of the petition and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.B.Jameel Arasu, Advocate for the petitioners and of MR.K.S.Durai Pandian, Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent 1, this Court made the following order:-

This petition is filed to extend the time granted to the petitioners in CrI.O.P.(MD)No.7130 of 2017, in the order dated 14.06.2017.

2. This Court by order dated 14.06.2017, granted two weeks time



to the petitioners to surrender before the learned III Additional District Judge(P.C.R.), Madurai. Since the petitioners could not appear within the time prescribed by this Court, the present petition is filed.

3. This Court is satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, for non-appearance of the petitioners within the time stipulated by this Court. Hence, the petitioners are at liberty to surrender before the trial Court within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on such surrender the learned III Additional District Judge(P.C.R.), Madurai, is directed to consider the bail petitions filed by the petitioners in connection with Crime No.272 of 2017, after hearing the defacto complainant on merits and in accordance with law.

4. This petition is allowed, accordingly.
