Prayer in WP(MD)Nos.10594 and 10596, 10597/2010:-

Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a WRIT OF MANDAMUS, directing the Respondents to implement the Selection Grade and Special Grade Scale of Pay as indicated in Schedule-II of the Tamil Nadu Revised Scales of Pay Rules 1998 at Rs.5000/- and 5500/- in WP.Nos.10594 and 10596 respectively and Rs.4000-5000/- in W.P.No.10597/2010 to the petitioner Driver from 01-01-1996 and pay all arrears within a stipulated time.

These Petitions seeking to condone the delay of 417 days in representing the Review Applications are allowed and the delay is condoned, on condition that the petitioners shall pay a sum of Rs.1,500/- in each appeal. (Totally, Rupees Four Thousand and Five Hundred only) within a period of two weeks from today, to the credit of creche account, Women Lawyer's Association, Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, Madurai. It is made clear that if the cost is not paid by the petitioners within the time stipulated in this order, the present Miscellaneous Petitions shall stand dismissed automatically without any further reference to this Court.
