Mr.D.Sivaraman, learned counsel takes notice for the respondent corporation.

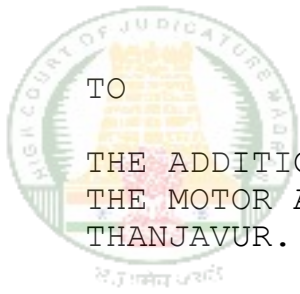
