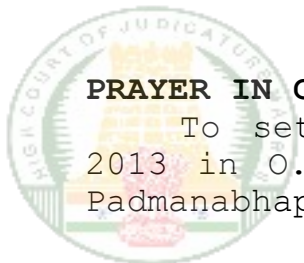

Accordingly, the delay is condoned and this petition is ordered on condition that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) to the Legal Aid Service Authority, attached to this Bench, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing which, this petition shall automatically be dismissed without further reference to this Court.
