2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent Police submitted that the investigation not yet complete. Appearance of the petitioner before the respondent police very much necessary in order to complete the investigation.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the gravity of offence committed by the petitioners, I am not inclined to relax the condition imposed by this Court in
