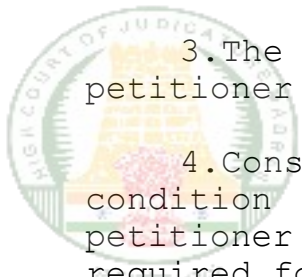
Prayer in CRL MP(MD). 9293/ 2017 in CRL OP(MD) No.11186 of 2017:
