The Petitioner filed this petition for relaxing the condition imposed by this Court for the offences punishable under Sections 341,324, 307 I.P.C., @ 341, 302 I.P.C @ 109,120(b), 147,148,341,624,307 & 302 I.P.C.,while granting bail.

2.Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that the petitioner is complying with the condition before the Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai regularly.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side), the condition already imposed on the petitioner is modified to the effect that, if charge sheet is not filed, the petitioner shall appear before the concerned Court twice in a week i.e., on every Monday at 10.30 a.m and every Friday at 10.30 a.m.,



until further orders and if charge sheet is filed, the petitioner shall appear before the concerned Court for each and every hearing.
