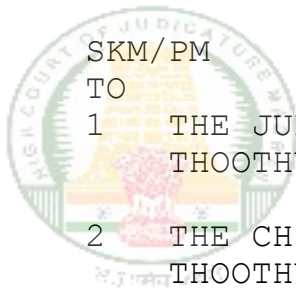
Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate [Criminal Side] for the respondent.
