Heard both sides.

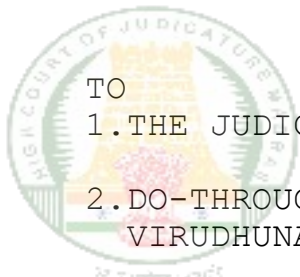
2. The learned Government Advocate (crl.side) submitted that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly from 12.01.2017 onwards.
