Prayer in CRL MP(MD). 10218/ 2016 :

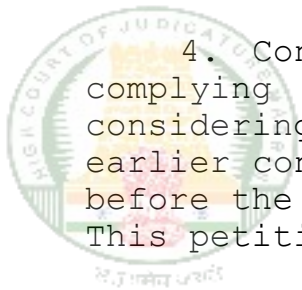
