2. The counsel for the petitioner states that 50% of the arrears of maintenance amount as on date, was deposited (Rs.85,000/- on 30.05.2017 and Rs.19,000/- on 02.06.2017), as per the order passed by this Court, dated 13.04.2017, by the petitioner herein and he has also filed a proof of deposit.

3. Further, the counsel for the petitioner agrees to withdraw the said deposited amount from the concerned Court by the respondent herein. Hence, the respondent is permitted to withdraw the said amount from the concerned Court on filing proper application.

4. The counsel for the respondent has no objection to allow this petition.



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5. In view of the compliance of the earlier order passed by this Court dated 13.04.2017, the delay of 882 days in filing the revision is condoned and the petition is allowed.
