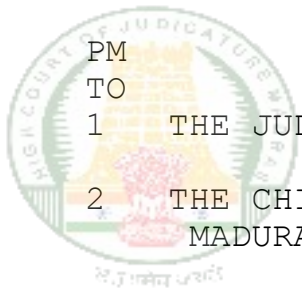
Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) for the respondent.
