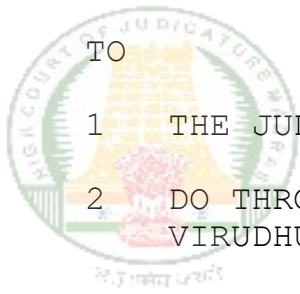
Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) for the respondent.
