Heard both sides.

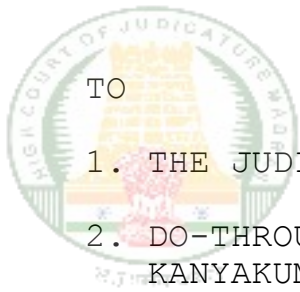
2.It is submitted by the learned Government Advocate(Criminal Side) that the petitioner is complying the earlier condition imposed by this Court, regularly.
