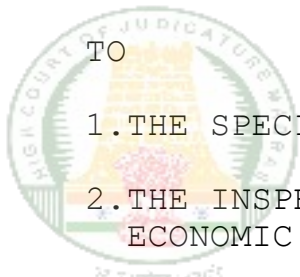
Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side).
