Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side).

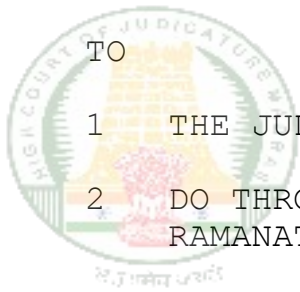
2.According to the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side), the petitioners are complying with the conditions imposed by this Court regularly.
