2. According to the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), the petitioner is complying with the condition imposed by this Court regularly.

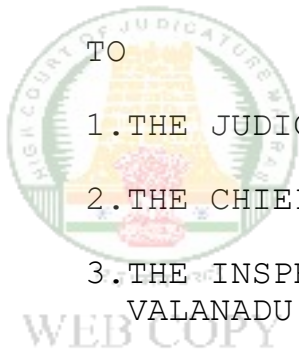
3. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the condition imposed on the petitioner stands fully relaxed.
