Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) for the Respondent.

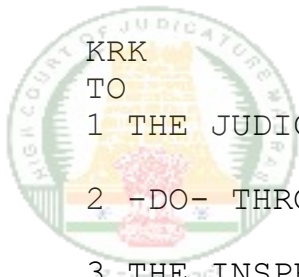
2. According to the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), the petitioner is complying with the conditions imposed by this Court regularly.
