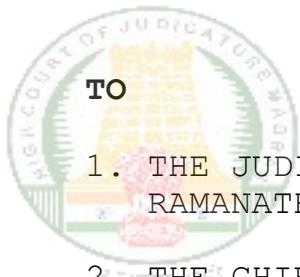
The learned counsel for the petitioner is present.
