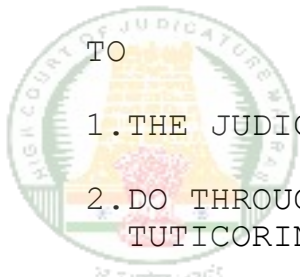
Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent.
