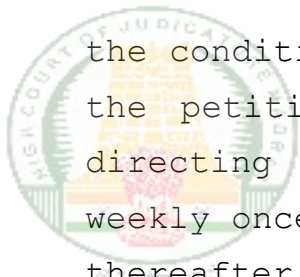
This petition is filed for relaxation of condition.
