Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent.

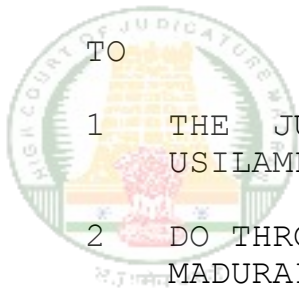
2.According to the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, the petitioners are complying with the condition imposed by this Court regularly.
