2.Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents/State and perused the materials placed before this Court.

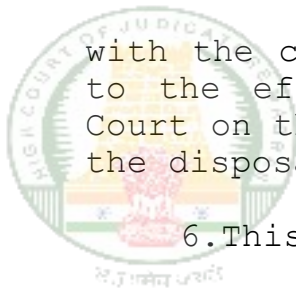
