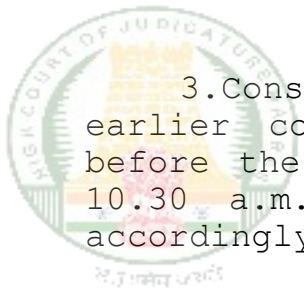
Prayer in CRL MP(MD). 5423/ 2017 IN CRL OP(MD)No.5959/17:
