The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that action has been dropped.

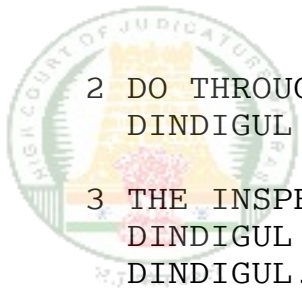
