Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.T.M.MADASAMY, Advocate for the petitioner and of M/S.C.VAKEESWARAN, Advocate on behalf of the sole Respondent the court made the following order:-

Against the order dismissing the petitioner's application to discharge him from the criminal case, the above revision has been filed with a delay of 660 days to condone the delay.

2. I have heard Mr.T.M.Madasamy, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.C.Vakeeswaran, learned counsel appearing for the respondent and I have gone through the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of this petition.

3. The reasons stated by the petitioner are not acceptable and not sufficient to condone the delay of 660 days. Hence, this delay condonation petition is dismissed.

4. At this juncture, the learned counsel appearing for the parties submitted that STC No.1515 of 2012 is pending from the year 2012 and now, P.W.1 was also examined.



5. In view of the above, the trial Court is directed to complete the trial in S.T.C.No.1515 of 2012 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
