3. The petitioners charged for the offences under Sections 120 (b),167, 409,465,471,477(A) IPC and 13(2) r/w13(1)(d) of preventing of anti-Corruption Act, 1988 in Crime No.1 of 2017 on the file of the respondent police.

4. Considering the reasons assigned for relaxation of condition and also the nature of charges pending against the petitioners, the condition already imposed on the petitioners is modified to the



effect that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent Police once in a month i.e on first Sunday of every English Calender month at 10.30 am until further orders.
