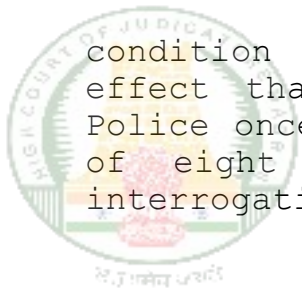
The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner is present and states that the petitioner is complying with the condition imposed by this Court regularly from 17.06.2017.

2.Mr.A.Ramar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent states that the petitioner is abiding the condition imposed by this Court regularly from 18.06.2017 and the investigation is still pending.

3. The petitioner charged for the offences under Sections 294 (b) and 307 of IPC @ 294(b), 323 and 302 of IPC in Crime No.514 of 2017 on the file of the respondent police.
