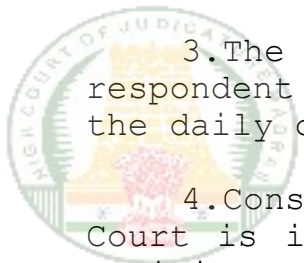
Prayer in CRL A(MD). 227/ 2017 :

Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.S.MAHENDRAPATHY, Advocate for the petitioners and of MR.A.RAMAR Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent the court made the following order:-
