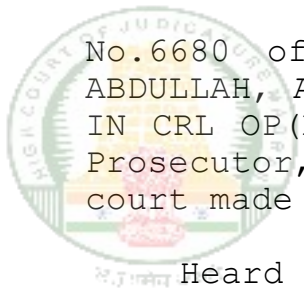
Prayer in CRL MP(MD) No.6680 of 2017 IN CRL OP(MD) No.5865 of 2017:
