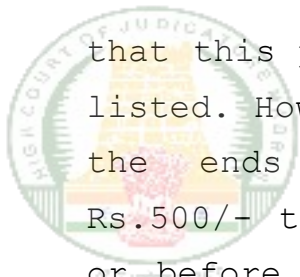

However, considering the facts and circumstances and to meet the ends of justice, the petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.500/- to the Legal Services Committee attached to this bench on or before 3 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police once in a week i.e on every Monday at 10.30 a.m for a period of four weeks, failing which, the order of relaxation shall stand dismissed automatically and on compliance, the condition will be relaxed.
